What is the "Irregular Migration" hackathon?)

The irregular Migration hackathon aims to bring together young people to outline all the root causes and consequences of the Irregular Migration problem and how it affects the EUROPE/MENA relationship, the participants will be guided by experts in the migration field to help them pitch their solutions, which will also be showcased on the Annual Conference in Berlin and be conveyed to European decision-makers. The Hackathon will help participants develop policies, projects, campaigns, or products that contribute to strengthening the EU's role in the MENA region.

We would like to include all young people across the MENA region who have a family member, a friend, or any kind of involvement related to individuals who experienced irregular migration to Europe.

What is included?

The hackathon participation is free and includes coffee breaks, lunches and a dinner. Additional travel and accommodation costs are also included.



Who can apply?

We welcome young people who have a family member, a friend, or any kind of involvement related to people experienced irregular migration, Eligibility criteria:

- Young people from the age 18 to 39
- Young people from and living in the following MENA countries
- Knowledge and experience about irregular migration from MENA region to Europe.
- Applicants must be able to communicate comfortably in English.
- Willingness and ability to travel to Tunisia from 12 July 14 July. 2023 Tickets and accommodation will be covered.
