Steffen Saebisch has been the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Friedrich Naumann Foundation for Freedom since 2014.

Steffen Saebisch studied Law in Hamburg from 1992 to 1998. He passed his second State Exam in 2001. From 1999 to 2002 he supported Dr. Heinrich Kolb, Member of the German Bundestag as a Research Associate. He was the Desk Officer for Social Policy of the FDP Parliamentary Group of the German Bundestag from 2002 to 2004. In 2004 Mr. Saebisch became the CEO of the FDP Parliamentary Group in the Berlin Parliament and returned to the German Bundestag as the Chief of the Planning Staff of the FDP Parliamentary Group in 2008. In 2009 he was asked by State Minister Dieter Posch to work as the State Secretary in the Hessian Ministry of Economics, Transportation and Regional Development. He left the ministry when the Hessian Government changed in 2014.

The Board of Directors appointed him CEO in 2014 and in 2018 again.
